




## Northern Scotland: Volume 6, Issue 1 (Paperback)

It contains substantial articles and book reviews, as well as interviews and reports of research projects in progress. Containing a variety of articles, reports, opinion pieces and reviews, Volume 6 (May 2015) considers crofting, visual culture and the integration of the elite and wider communities of the Northern Highlands, space and place in 18th Century Northern Isles as well as the children of free coloured women and Highland Scots in Guyana.
