Pregnancy and estrangement lead to a paternity suit leaving both parties deeply and permanently scarred. Narrated from the viewpoint of the boy, Philip, brought up by his single parent, Heather. The tale evokes the atmosphere of Fifties and Sixties in rural England as a boy of mixed race with an absent father. It describes the slow process of mother and son coming to terms with their situation and tentatively learning how to talk about it. Out of this evolves the desire to know what has become of the father who had departed the scene in such dramatic circumstances. Thus Philip, at his mother s behest, comes to begin what was a long and tortuous search based on very little data. Background to the narrative is provided by the intercultural context of the author s adult life in Germany and ongoing research...
